



## Hawai'i Island Student Scuba Scholarship Program

**Ocean Defenders Alliance (ODA)**, a nonprofit organization dedicated to a clean and debris-free ocean, is sponsoring the **Hawai'i Island Scuba Scholarship Program**.

**Over a dozen scholarships for Open Water and Dive Against Debris certifications are being awarded to students between the ages of 15 and 18 years, currently attending high school, and permanently residing on the Island of Hawai'i.**

The applications will be reviewed, and scholarship recipients selected, by a committee consisting of staff from ODA.

- Each scholarship recipient will receive an **Open Water Certification** course provided through Kohala Divers LTD using their facilities and dive boat.
- Each student will earn a **Dive Against Debris Certification** during a scheduled ODA cleanup following the completion of the student's Open Water Certification.
- **Four students will be chosen** from all scholarship recipients to receive a 2-tank dive day (2 sites) and use of an ODA GoPro to document and film their dives. They will be selected based on demonstrated commitment to the program, enthusiasm, and willingness to follow all instruction during the Open Water Certification process.
- **The four selected students will submit an edited video and a 5-paragraph essay** describing why they filmed what they did and why it is important to them. As an alternative to the essay, the applicant may choose to be interviewed, either in-person or by Zoom.
- **A \$200 gift card for Kohala Divers LTD will be awarded** to one the four selected students based on their essay and video.

### Guidelines & Priorities

- Applicants must be **currently enrolled high school students between 15 and 18 years old**. They should have a passion for conservation, a desire for continuing education in a related field, and eagerness to educate others.
- Applicants must have a **total family annual income under \$90,000**.
- Scholarship funds will be paid **upon completion of the course with all requirements met**. This includes earning both Open Water Certification and Dive Against Debris Certification.
- **The scholarship award will be paid directly to Kohala Divers LTD** who will be providing the certification.

**Please submit as soon as possible so that we can arrange the interviews and look into scheduling a class.**

*\*\*If the student gets sick, cannot clear their ears, a family emergency occurs, etc. the student has 1 (one) year from selection notice to complete their scuba diving certifications of Open Water and Dive Against Debris (space available on standby basis, in already occurring course); however, they will not be able to be chosen as the recipient of the gift certificate after certification is complete.*
